

SPO concert dress code.

Male / gender diverse:

Formal black jacket with black collared shirt (can be short sleeved), open neck no tie.

Retain option for no jackets for June – This would be confirmed to the orchestra on the weekend. If not wearing a jacket, shirts sleeves should be long and buttoned at cuff, not rolled up.

Smart black trousers.

Black socks.

Smart all black concert shoes.

Female / gender diverse:

Smart black top and trousers /skirt, or dress. If opting for a skirt or dress, the length should be at least down to the knee.

Colour should be all black, avoiding sequins, glitter, coloured highlights and embellishments Black socks or black tights.

Smart all black concert shoes.

Additional notes for dress / top styling:

Spaghetti straps should be avoided, and tailored style wide straps should be the minimum.

Additional accessories:

Please avoid taking additional non-musical instrument accessories (handbags and the like) onto stage. If required they should be small and, ideally, black.

Splashes of colour: SPO long service pins may be worn with pride, otherwise splashes of colour should be avoided unless notified as acceptable, or requested, for a particular concert.

Note: All concert dress should be modest and should **not** be skin tight, low cut, high slit, strappy or backless. The following materials should be avoided: denim, suede, leather, PVC.

The outfit should not draw attention to individuals which detracts from the music.

No logos should be visible with the exception of a small SPO logo.
